Waste Bins

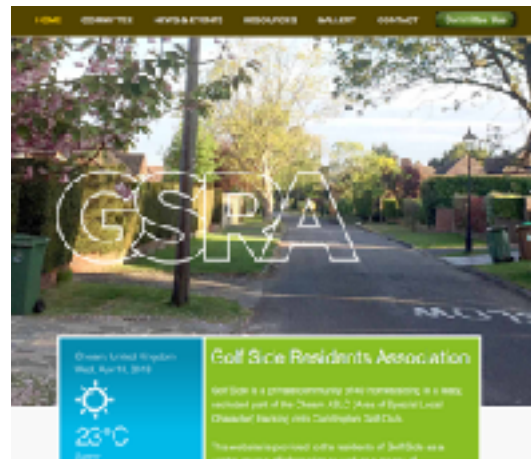
Please put your bins away. When left out on the verge for prolonged periods of time they not only look messy but they can blow over dumping the contents up and down the road.
