You can also take your real Christmas tree for free to the Household Reuse and Recycling Centre at Kimpton Park Way.

Make space for recycling this Christmas



Most of us produce more recycling over the Christmas and New Year period. If your green recycling box is full, you can put your plastics, glass, cans and cartons in untied plastic bags, cardboard boxes or your own plastic boxes. Pop them next to your recycling box on collection day and our crews will make sure it all gets recycled.

No space in your food waste bin? Put your kitchen caddy out as well as your food waste bin on your collection day.
