

RECYCLING AND RUBBISH COLLECTION TIMETABLE 2023-2024



Your collection day is WEDNESDA

Please remember to put your bins out by 6am



- Collections will change over the Christmas and New Year period and may take place up to four days later than usual. This calendar shows your revised collection days where appropriate.
- Real Christmas tree collections start on 8th January. Put your tree out from Monday 8th January and it will be collected as soon as possible.

Street Lamps

Please remember it is your responsibility to report to Sutton Council when a bulb is burned-out in the lamppost in front of your property.

It really helps if you....

Flatten cardboard boxes before putting them in the green wheelie bin

Empty and rinse all containers before putting them in the green box

Remove film lids from plastic pots, tubs and trays (put the film lids in your brown wheelie bin)

Only place items that cannot be recycled in your brown wheelie bin - no food waste please

On collection day, place your bins at the **front edge** of your property, close to the pavement but not on it
